In the event that your child becomes critically unwell/injured or experiences a significant medical episode (compromised breathing; prolonged seizure etc), our response may include calling an ambulance. As a regional resident, St John Country Ambulance Cover is available, which includes as many emergency or necessary non-emergency transports you, or one of your family members require, for an annual cost of \$107 Family or \$64 Single. 
